The purpose of the resolution is to send a letter of support for a basic income guarantee through Bill S-233 "an act to develop a national framework for a guaranteed livable basic income". The letter will go to the Federal, Provincial, local MPP/MPs, and federation of Canadian municipalities.

At the November 18th meeting, a 5 minute deputation can be done to speak to the resolution. A couple of FPC members can speak to the need for the municipality to support a federally-funded guaranteed livable basic income (each deputation should be different). Members can also send an email to council if they are not comfortable speaking in-person at council. Sharmini will provide all the information for members to develop their speaking points.
